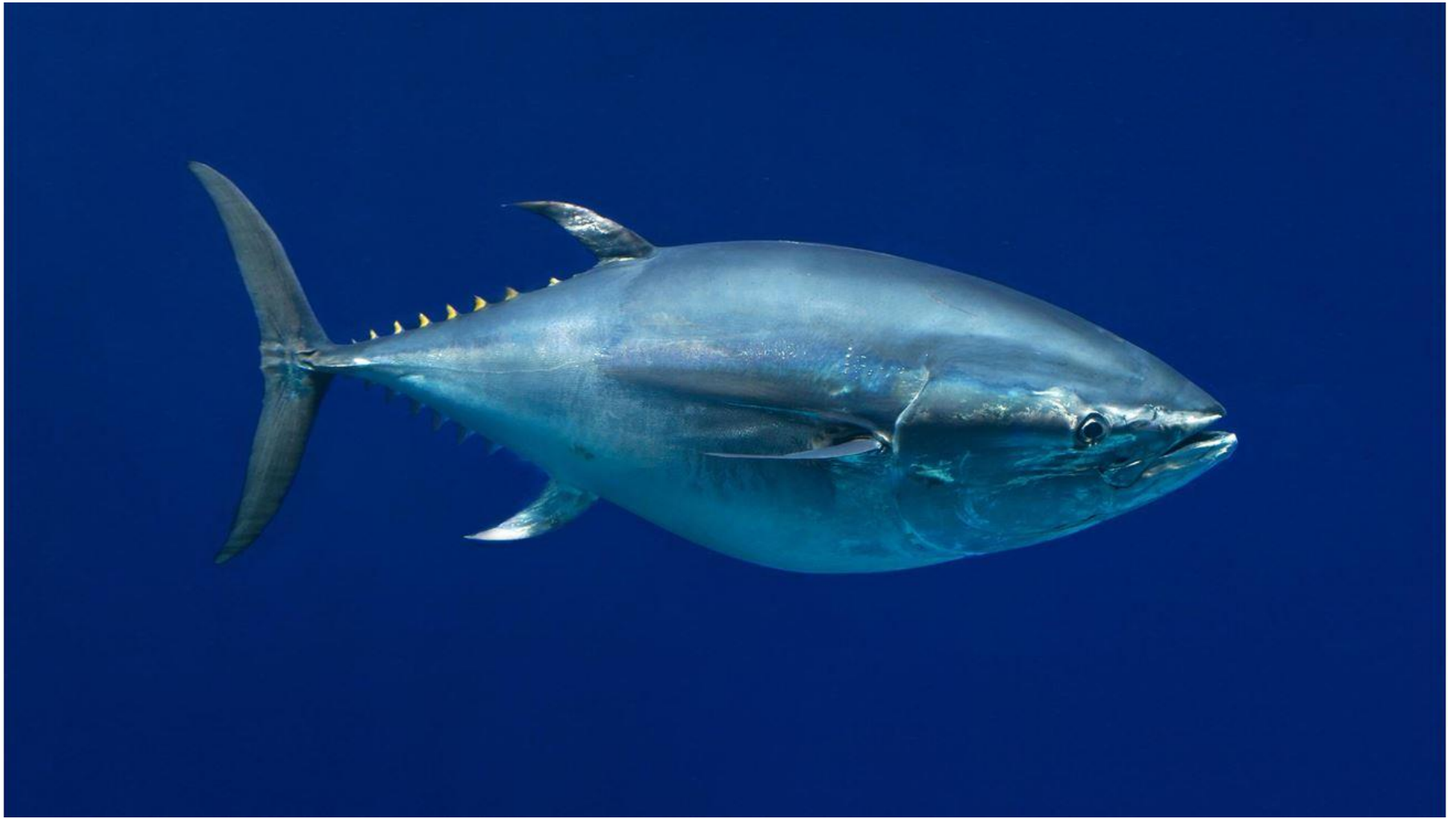


















#	Species	Fish?	Notes
1	Blue-spotted grouper	YES	Has backbone, eyes, mouth, fins, scales, and gills.
2	Hawksbill sea turtle	no	Reptile! No gills (breathes air). Does have fins (flippers) and scales.
3	Clown anemonefish	YES	Has backbone, eyes, mouth, fins, scales, and gills.
4	Spotted eagle ray	YES	The wings are the fins. Look carefully for the gills in the underside.
5	Atlantic spotted dolphin	no	Mammal! No scales or gills. Does have fins.
6	Longhorn cowfish	YES	Funny shape, but has backbone, eyes, mouth, fins, scales, and gills.
7	Common octopus	no	Invertebrate! No backbone, fins, or scales.
8	California sea lion	no	Mammal! No fins, gills, or scales.
9	Seahorse	YES	Funny shape, but has backbone, eyes, mouth, fins, scales, and gills.
10	Pacific sea nettle (jelly)	no	Invertebrate! No backbone, eyes, gills, scales, mouth, or fins.
11	Grayface moray eel	YES	Long shape, but has backbone, eyes, mouth, fins, scales, and gills.
12	Great white shark	YES	Has backbone, eyes, mouth, fins, scales, and gills.
13	Scuba diver 😊	no	Human! No fins, scales, or gills. Notice tank of air on her back.
14	Pacific Bluefin tuna	YES	Has backbone, eyes, mouth, fins, scales, and gills.
15	Ochre star	no	Invertebrate! No backbone, eyes, fins, gills, or scales.
16	Orca	no	Mammal! No gills or scales. Does have fins.
