- **Deforestation:** Cutting down forests to make room for farms, ranches, cities, or other uses.
- **Emissions:** The release of something, like pollution from a car's tailpipe.
- **Entomophagy:** The practice of eating insects.
- **Food waste**: Food that is thrown away instead of eaten.
- **Greenhouse gases:** Gases in Earth's atmosphere, such as carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>), that absorb infrared radiation and trap heat.
- **Grubs:** The worm-like larvae of insects, such as beetles.
- **Insects:** Small invertebrate animals with segmented bodies, three pairs of legs, and typically a pair or two of wings. Insects are the most diverse group of animals on Earth.
- Larva: The immature form of an animal that looks very different from an adult.
- **Sustainable:** Meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs.
