



Pet a Lambeosaurus

How would it have felt to pet a dinosaur? Fossilized skin impressions tell us that some dinosaur skin was scaly, like reptile skin, and some was armor-plated for extra protection, with circular scales packed tightly together with flexible edges where they touched.

Materials

Lambeosaurus outline drawing (page 2) White glue Dry lentils

Directions

- 1. **Print** the *Lambeosaurus* outline on page 2.
- 2. **Add** a drop of glue inside the *Lambeosaurus* drawing and spread it around with a Q-tip, creating a thin layer.
- 3. Place lentils, one by one, onto the glue.
- 4. **Repeat** until the entire area inside of the *Lambeosaurus* drawing is covered in lentils. Tip: work in one small area at a time to prevent the glue from drying too quickly.
- 5. Wipe off any extra glue and allow to dry flat.
- 6. **Run your fingers** gently along the top of the lentils to pretend you're petting a dinosaur. How does it feel?
